

## GLOBAL HEALTH EXPERIENCE PHLEBOTOMY RECORD

Students required to complete ITD357/Simulated Procedures/Reducing Risk in Low-Resource Settings must also complete supervised phlebotomies in the UPHS at least two weeks before departure for planned clinical experience in a low resource area. Phlebotomies and documentation via this form must be handled as follows:

1. Before printing this form, electronically fill information at the bottom: your name, location of your global health experience (GHE), and start date of GHE below.
2. Schedule work with a phlebotomist by contacting lead outpatient phlebotomist Gloria Mathis: 215-776-5624. Print full name of supervising phlebotomist in appropriate column below.
3. Complete ten supervised phlebotomies and record below. For the "Patient Initials" column, note **only** initials (no full names, stickers, or other patient identifiers). Sign form at bottom.
4. Make a copy of this record to give to your supervisor/mentor when you arrive in the low resource area as proof of completion of the phlebotomy requirement.

**Note: Fulfillment of the phlebotomy requirement is a pre-requisite to travel. Failure to submit a completed record as instructed could result in cancellation of both CGH support and permission to participate fully in your planned clinical experience.**
