The AFYA BORA CONSORTIUM is recruiting 20 highly qualified and goal-oriented health professionals for a 12-month fellowship (July, 2012 – June, 2013) in one of our African partner countries (Botswana, Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda). There are 4 openings for applicants from each of the African countries, and 4 openings for US trainees from the US partner institutions.



The Fellowship

The purpose of the Afya Bora Fellowship is to provide trainees with a set of practical skills that will prepare them for leadership positions in government, non-government, and academic health institutions in developing countries. The training program will be conducted in Africa. It has two components: a 9-week Core Curriculum plus 3 distance learning modules, and two 4.5 month attachments to an academic, governmental, or non-governmental organization in one of the African partner countries.

About the Consortium

The Afya Bora Consortium is a partnership of 8 academic health centers, four in Africa and four in the United States.
