

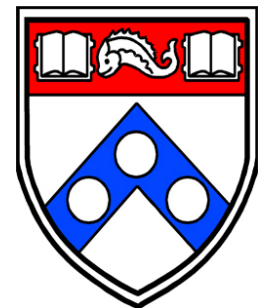

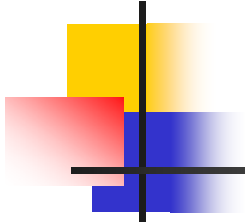

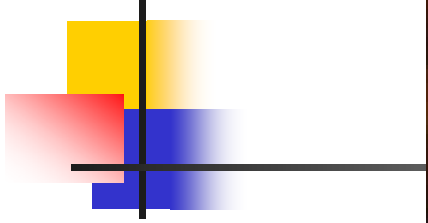


Princess Marina Hospital, Gaborone, Botswana

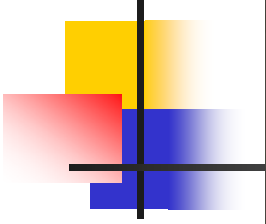
