## WHEN:

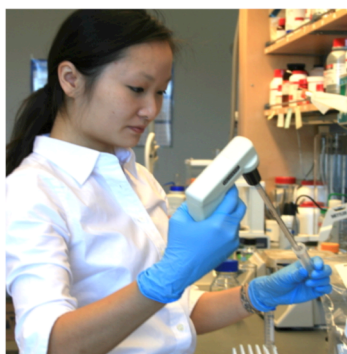
Summer between the first and second year, or between the second and third year, of medical school.
