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**PROTOCOL TITLE:** A small mechanistic, within-subject design, single-site study to investigate the effects of short term olanzapine administration on early phase insulin release, insulin sensitivity and glucose appearance in healthy control subjects.

We are seeking paid volunteers for a study that examines the effects of a schizophrenia medication on insulin and glucose levels in healthy individuals. You will be reimbursed up to \$3000 for your participation. You may qualify if you are:

- male or female
- age 18-40
- healthy

Study involves 2 outpatient visits and 1 inpatient stay of 12 days at the Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania. Study also requires taking an FDA approved schizophrenia medication called olanzapine for 9 days. We will also be drawing blood and measuring activity levels.
