



The MBE Travel Fund – Call for Applications

What:

The MBE Travel Fund is the result of a 2007 Bioethics Alumni Society Initiative. The Fund is designed to provide small travel grants to current MBE students who are presenting papers at professional bioethics-related conferences. The money is to be used towards expenses associated with attending the conference.

Amount:

For the 2007/2008 academic year, The MBE Travel Fund may award up to \$200 travel grants to up to 3 students.

Eligible Expenses:

Travel expenses (airfare, bus, train, cab)
Hotel expenses
Conference Registration Fee

Details:

There are 2 ways the MBE Travel Fund awards can be distributed:

- 1) An eligible expense (i.e., Amtrak ticket, registration fee) can be presented to the MBE office and we will pay directly.
- 2) Students accrue eligible expenses during the trip and return receipts for reimbursement upon return.

Deadline:

Applications are accepted on a rolling basis.
