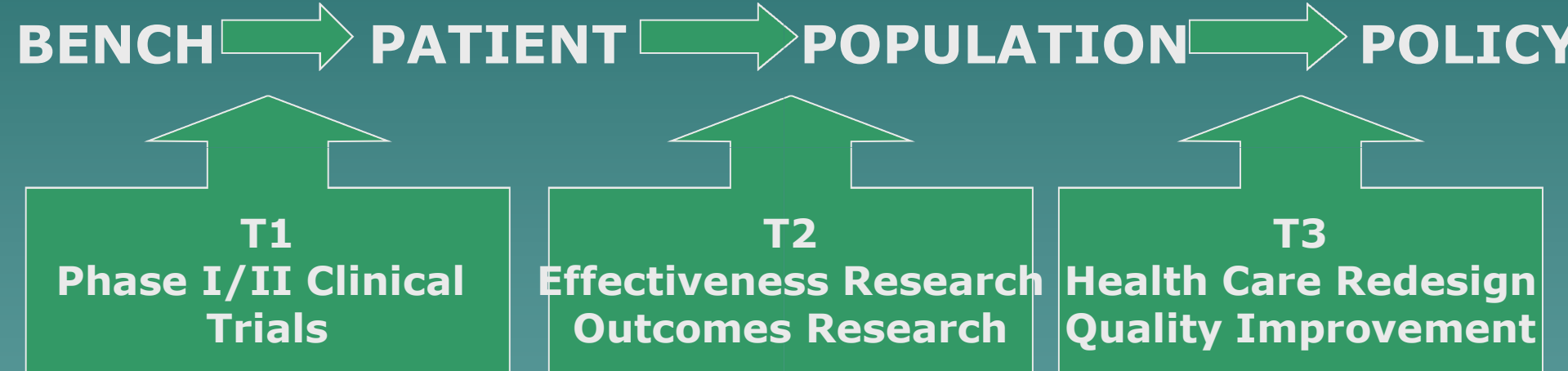

Doris Duke Clinical Research Fellowship Program

- Started in 2001 (Penn 2002)
- 1 year fellowships – clinical research
- Open to students at any U.S. Medical school
- Emphasizes mentoring with clinical researchers or research teams
- Provides didactic and research experience
- Based at 12 medical schools

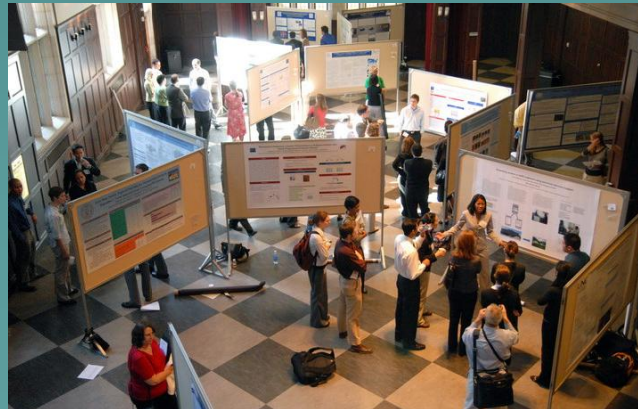
Key features of the DDCRF

- Students receive:
 - \$28,000/year stipend
 - health insurance
 - additional funds to support research and travel
- 12 CRF schools:
 - Domestic: 5+ fellows/year – 3 from host institution; 2 from other medical schools
 - International: 2 fellows/year – 1 from host institution; 1 from other medical school
- National meeting at end of fellowship to present research



Features of DDCRF at Penn

- Program Leaders, staff, advisory committee
- Identification of best mentors in concert with proposed research interests
- Complementary didactics (courses: epidemiology & biostatistics; monthly journal club)
- 2/year presentations by fellows
- Preparation for national meeting hosted by DDCRF (research presentations) and NIH meeting for year out programs



International DDCRF Program

- 2 fellows will spend part of the year at Penn and the remainder in Gaborone, Botswana
- Research projects on HIV/AIDS at Princess Marina Hospital and the University of Botswana
