Stipends: Allowable as cost-of-living allowances for trainees and fellows only under NIH training grants and fellowships. These payments are made according to a pre-established schedule based on the individual's experience and level of training. Stipends are not a fee-for-service payment and are not allowable under research grants even when they appear to benefit the research project

STIPENDS: Effective with all Kirschstein-NRSA awards made on or after October 1, 2010, the following annual stipend levels apply to all individuals receiving support through institutional research training grants or individual fellowships, including the Minority Access to Research Career (MARC) and Career Opportunities in Research (COR) programs. These awards are made under the authority of Section 487 of the Public Health Service Act
