

Black Queer Town Hall in STEM

January 12th-15th

Significantly, on **January 12th-15th**, in collaboration with the University of Pennsylvania, University of Iowa, and Black Queer Town Hall, we present Black Queer Town Hall in STEM. Notably, this is a virtual four-day conference to increase Black Queer scientists' visibility worldwide. Join us for a day of panels on **January 12 starting at 9:30AM EST** to connect and learn about Black Queer scientists' adversities in and out of the lab. Equally, this is an opportunity for institutions to learn how to increase Black Queer representation in STEM and foster community among Black Queer scientists. The Black Queer Town Hall in STEM will be hosted by Trans actor/entertainer and activist Miss Peppermint, from RuPaul's Drag Race and appearances by Bob the Drag Queen from RuPaul's Drag Race.

Subsequently, **January 13-15 starting at 8:20AM EST** are filled with seminars presented by Black Queer scientists from around the world with topics ranging from physics, biology, biochemistry, chemistry, bioengineering, epidemiology, and sociology.
