(NEW) - Important Reminder - Update "Learning from" Address Information

This is a reminder to add your Local and "Learning from" addresses in <u>Penn InTouch</u> if you have not already done so. This is especially important if you are working remotely and not coming to campus to participate in the screening testing.

You can add or update your address by logging into <u>Penn InTouch</u> and going to "Profile, privacy & emergency" then selecting "Address information".

COVID-19 Requirements

Vaccinations. Penn students, faculty, and staff are required to be vaccinated. Students must upload their vaccine record through <u>Student Health</u>. Information regarding current student immunization requirements can be found <u>here</u>.

Masking/Testing. All members of the Penn community and visitors must wear masks while indoors in public or shared spaces. In addition, **twice-a-week** Penn Cares screening testing is required for members of our community who are not vaccinated or choose not to report their vaccination information.
