Mexican: Rafa's: N. side of Spruce, between 38th & 37th: Burritos with perfectly crisped wraps, enchiladas with Christmas (banderita) sauce. Al pastor special is awesome.

Mexican: Dos Memo's: W. side of 38th between Spruce and Locust. Tacos Pastor & Carnitas.

Korean-Mexican Fusion: Tyson B's, South and 33rd East side. Korean BBQ short rib burrito!

Korean: Kami, 33 & Market: Kimchi rice, Bimbap

Korean: Sopoong: 38th and Spruce, Spicy Pork, Kimbap. The rice is excellent

Middle Eastern/Mediterranean Halal Truck: NW corner of 38rd and Spruce, the one closest to 38th: Best of the halal gyro trucks, imo. Falafel perfectly cooked. Ask for red white and green (chutney) sauces on your food.

Vietnamese: Can Tho City: S. side of Spruce, between 38th & 37th. Pork chop with rice, Banh Mi.

Hoagies: Hemo's S. side of Spruce, between 38th & 37th. Fresh grilled chicken with Hemo's special sauce

Asian: Joy Truck. SW corner of 38th & Spruce. good for breakfast and lunch. Spicy Thai chicken.

Asian: Miss Lee's. 38th & Hamilton Walk. Halal. Chicken Lo Mein: tasty well marinated chicken

Chinese: Kims Lunch Truck. Next to Pottruck. Chicken w. eggplant, black bean sauce, spicy.

Carribean: Caribbean Feast. W. side of 38th between Spruce and Locust. Jerk chicken, curry chicken!

Lyn's: Breakfast/Hoagies. S. side of Spruce, @ 36th: A food truck legend: Low prices, always busy but with incredible throughput. Bacon/Egg/Cheese on anything. Good BLT's
