What is Slack?

A "message board" system, that can be accessed via web, computer, or mobile apps.

Why is CAMRIS using Slack?

- UPennMRI Slack has been active unofficially since 2017.
- Now has over 500 users; increasing "informal" CAMRIS communications.
- Slack offers an alternative to "group emails", ensuring conversations on persistent topics have a persistent home.
- It itegrates with many other software tools (e.g., Statuspage updates automatically create messages in Slack)

 Scheduling requests should still be emailed to Margaret.

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

Updates and Plans for Statuspage

- Should now have all CAMRIS-supported equipment listed (if something is missing, tell us in #technical-issues).
- Recently improved auto-posting of updates in #technical-issues to make it less "chatty".
- 45 direct subscribers today; we want to understand barriers to use. Are the messages unclear? Are there too many irrelevant messages? Would you like to subscribe only to messages in certain bays?

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Stimulus Response Hardware

- Inventory of stimulus response equipment across all CAMRIS bays.
- Established service contract; now cycling equipment back to vendor for repair.
- Trialing new-generation interface module at Stellar Chance 7T. Will become standard inteface at SC3T within next two weeks. Check it out, ask questions, and give feedback.
- Once repairs/replacement of hardware complete (Summer 2023), will have spares on hand for all response hardware, minimizing downtime.
- If you find something broken, let the local technologist know so they swap it with the spare or escalate the issue. If no technologist is on hand, please post to #technical-issues.

Bore-End Display Screens

- We've had multiple failures/issues in the last 6 months.
- Repaired screen at SC7T (leaking RF noise)
- Identified that SC3T screen is "happier" when stored outside fringe field. Sign posted on screen directing operators to move it away from scanner when not in use.
- "Borrowed" screen from MRD1 to replace broken screen at HUP6.
- Urgently working to service or replace HUP6 screen.
- Evaluating plans for long-term service/replacements.

Stellar Chance Cooling

- Scanner cooling water system has been broken at Stellar Chance for several months.
- A few users, particulalry at 7T, have experienced cooling errors.
- In consultation with PSOM and FRES, contracting for repairs to cooling system.
- Will take at minimum 12 weeks to complete repairs.
- May involve some minimal scanner downtime, which will be communicated once we have additional info.
- Groups experincing cooling errors on any scanner should immediately report them to #technical-issues.



- Major "research" sequences (e.g., UMinn BOLD/diffusion) are now available for XA software.
- MRD1 is already upgraded, but has extremely limited time for protocol testing.
- PAV10 will be the testbed for protocol upgrades and be more available to XA techdev time.

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
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- Mark has reprogrammed the phones at SC3T and SC7T to only ring when the bay phone number are called (check PBR calendar for phone #s).
- All operators (Level 2, techdev, technologists, etc.) must now answer the phone when it rings.
- Do not reprogram the phones to ring for other lines.

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Restructuring policies and drafting processes to:

- Improve clarity and practicality for scanner users and staff.
- Produce a single, structured repository of policies.
- Iteratively improve policies via regularly scheduled reviews.
- Include user community in the generation and review of policy.



First batch of revised policies on website July 1 All policies updated over next academic year

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Preview of scheduling and billing for next fiscal year	

Rates to increase by no more than 3% for next FY. No major changes to fee structures.

Proposed billing changes (policy will be finalized before July):

- Slots will be billed for the full duration of the booking.
- Booking is for the bay, not just the scanner. Log in when you enter the bay and log out as you leave.
- If you run over, you will be billed additionally in 10 minute increments.
- You will not be charged for time that is not available to you because a previous group ran long.
- No-show will be billed at an hourly rate (no-show for a 3-hour slot acrues 3x no-show rate).
- To receive refund for time lost due to technical issues, you must report them immediately to #technical-issues, or confirm that the issue is already posted on the Statuspage.

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New Protocol Submission Process

- You can find the redcap portal here along with information on what documents and other requirements are needed.
- Incomplete or incorrect applications will not be reviewed by the committee. When in doubt please reach out to Margaret Ryan or Norman Butler for help.
- Be sure to include all necessary CAMRIS safety clauses in your ICF.

CAMRIS's PBR Main Portal

- http://pathbio.med.upenn.edu/pbr/portal/ is the website portal for the main pbr section
- Here PI's, BA's or lab managers can add or delete lab members for each protocol.
- This is also where funding is linked to CAMRIS approved protocols.
- It is the responsibility of each research group to manage lab member access and funding linkage by protocol.

CAMRIS's PBR Calendar Access

- https://pathbio.med.upenn.edu/camris/dogfish/ is the website to access the CAMRIS calendar
- Anyone can log in with their user name and pennkey for a "read only" view.
- Lab members will have specific protocols under their profile and will be able to book scan time once the funding and calendar access steps are completed in the main pbr after CAMRIS gives full approval.
- Please update your user profile so CAMRIS has accurate information (e.g. valid Penn email and a good phone number).

CAMRIS's PBR Calendar Access

- The various scanner schedules open a new week of booking time, 3 weeks out, every Tuesday morning at 9:30 am.
- Some complicated protocols can be designated as CAT1, which lets a lab book out further on some scanners.
- However a Pennchart order number MUST be listed in order to hold the slot.
- If this is not done, your reservation might be removed and/or CAT1 status might be cancelled.

CAMRIS's PBR Calendar Access

For non-CAT1 protocols, scheduling time outside of the 3 week window is possible by contacting:

- Jacqui Meeks (MRI tech) for SC3T and 7T (Stellar chance)
- For Pav10, all booking is done by the HUP6 techs at this time.
- Also contact HUP6 techs if you need to schedule on Devon scanners or HUP5.

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
