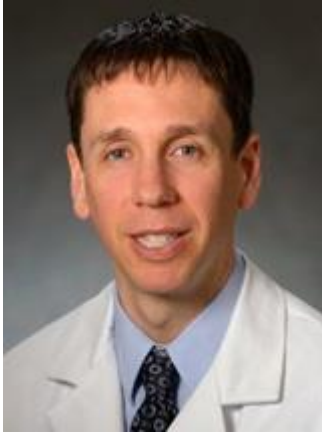

Liver metastasis is a key determinant of cancer morbidity and mortality and associates with treatment resistance. This is particularly evident in gastrointestinal malignancies, especially pancreatic cancer. In this talk, I will discuss determinants within the liver that facilitate liver metastasis and the role of the liver in coordinating immune evasion in cancer. Overall, the talk aims to provide insights into potential strategies for intervening on liver biology as a therapeutic approach in cancer.
