MOLECULAR TEST	ANTIGEN TEST	ANTIBODY TEST
Diagnostic test, viral test, molecular test, nucleic acid amplification test [NAAT], RT-PCR test, LAMP test	Diagnostic test, viral test, rapid test	Serological test, serology, blood test, serology test
