Keynote Speaker: Dr. Mingmar Sherpa



Dr. Mingmar Sherpa was born and raised in Phaplu, Solokhumbu, in the foothills of Mt. Everest. Unlike his Sherpa peers who took up climbing with ambitions of scaling Everest, Dr. Mingmar spent his time reading. He was the first physician in the Sherpa community. He served his community for several years as a rural physician. He spent some time in Kathmandu when he led the Ministry of Health. His heart, however, was always in rural Nepal.

After retirement, he learned point-of-care ultrasound which he taught to nurses and midwives to spot high-risk pregnancies and divert such patients to more advanced obstetric care than is available in remote areas. His efforts have substantially reduced maternal mortality, particularly in Western Nepal. His endeavor is the finest case study of "imaging saves lives."
