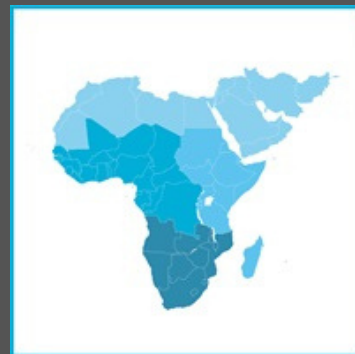


Penn Radiology Global Health Imaging Case Competition
