June 23 – July 7, 2023

APPLICATION DEADLINE

January 3, 2023

ELIGIBILITY

FASPE Medical applicants must fit into one of following categories: 1) be enrolled in an MD or DO program (or equivalent) at the time of their application and anticipate completion of at least one clinical year prior to the start of the fellowship; OR 2) be enrolled in a residency program.

FASPE programs are non-denominational. Candidates of all religious, ethnic and cultural backgrounds are encouraged to apply.

FASPE Medical (Fellowships at Auschwitz for the Study of Professional Ethics) is **a fully-funded two-week international summer program** that uses the conduct of doctors and other medical professionals in Nazi Germany as a launching point and backdrop for an intensive study of contemporary medical ethics and leadership.

Fellows visit Auschwitz and other sites in **Germany and Poland** where they consider how to apply the lessons of history to the ethical challenges they will face in their careers.

All program costs are covered, including the equivalent of round-trip travel from New York to Europe, as well as all European travel, lodging and food.
