Application Fee Waiver Policy**

**Application Fee Exemptions**

Applicants with the affiliations listed below are **exempt** from the non-refundable application fee:

1. University of Pennsylvania employees (including Department of Radiation Oncology post-doctoral fellows) and undergraduate students applying for submatriculation
2. Veterans

**Eligibility for Application Fee Waiver**

Applicants with financial need AND a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or greater **can apply for an application fee waiver**. Applicants are required to provide at least one of the following documents demonstrating financial need:

1. A copy of a letter on official letterhead from a government agency verifying that you or your family have qualified for public assistance based on low income criteria anytime within the past 5 years
2. A copy of your financial aid award letter from another / previous institution dated within the past 5 years
3. A copy of your approved GRE fee waiver (for tests taken within 5 years of the application deadline)
4. A copy of your federal Student Aid Report (SAR) that verifies you qualified for financial aid within the past 5 years based on a family contribution\* of:
  - Not more than \$1,500 if the student is a dependent student
  - Not more than \$1,900 if the student is an independent student

**Process**

Email the MPPG Team at [MPP-info@uphs.upenn.edu](mailto:MPP-info@uphs.upenn.edu) with "Application Fee Waiver Request" in the subject line and attach financial documentation (listed above). If approved, the MPPG Team will provide a one-time use fee waiver code for you to put on the application for admission in order to waive the application fee. Application fee waiver requests are due by **December 15** to ensure time for evaluation and processing.
