

## University of Pennsylvania Medical Physics Graduate Programs Application Fee Waiver Policy

## **Application Fee Exemptions**

Applicants with the affiliations listed below are **exempt** from the non-refundable application fee:

- University of Pennsylvania employees (including Department of Radiation Oncology postdoctoral fellows) and undergraduate students applying for submatriculation
- 2. Veterans

## **Eligibility for Application Fee Waiver**

Applicants with financial need AND a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or greater can apply for an application fee waiver. Applicants are required to provide at least one of the following documents demonstrating financial need:

- 1. A copy of a letter on official letterhead from a government agency verifying that you or your family have qualified for public assistance based on low income criteria anytime within the past 5 years
- 2. A copy of your financial aid award letter from another / previous institution dated within the past 5 years
- 3. A copy of your approved GRE fee waiver (for tests taken within 5 years of the application deadline)
- 4. A copy of your federal Student Aid Report (SAR) that verifies you qualified for financial aid within the past 5 years based on a family contribution\* of:
  - O Not more than \$1,500 if the student is a dependent student
  - o Not more than \$1,900 if the student is an independent student

## **Process**

Email the MPGP Team at <a href="MPP-info@uphs.upenn.edu">MPP-info@uphs.upenn.edu</a> with "Application Fee Waiver Request" in the subject line and attach financial documentation (listed above). If approved, the MPGP Team will provide a one-time use fee waiver code for you to put on the application for admission in order to waive the application fee. Application fee waiver requests are due by **December 15** to ensure time for evaluation and processing.
