


# Outcomes of Consideration for Appointment and Promotions to Full Professor on the Tenure Track Perelman School of Medicine 2009-10 to 2019-20



















### Total Publication Statistics for Promotions to Full Professor on the Tenure Track Perelman School of Medicine 2009-10 to 2019-20






### Total Publication Statistics for Promotions to Full Professor on the Clinician Educator Track Perelman School of Medicine 2009-10 to 2019-20









### Publications From Prior Rank for Promotions to Full Professor on the Tenure Track Perelman School of Medicine 2009-10 to 2019-20






### Publications From Prior Rank for Promotions to Full Professor on the Clinician Educator Track Perelman School of Medicine 2009-10 to 2019-20


#### Years in Prior Rank at Time of Promotion



### Years at Prior Rank for Promotions to Full Professor on the Tenure Track Perelman School of Medicine 2009-10 to 2019-20




### Years at Prior Rank for Promotions to Associate Professor on the Tenure Track Perelman School of Medicine 2009-10 to 2019-20




### Years at Prior Rank for Promotions to Full Professor on the Clinician Educator Track Perelman School of Medicine 2009-10 to 2019-20




## Years at Prior Rank for Promotions to Associate Professor on the Clinician Educator Track Perelman School of Medicine 2009-10 to 2019-20




### Years at Prior Rank for Promotions to Full Professor on the Research Track Perelman School of Medicine 2009-10 to 2019-20
