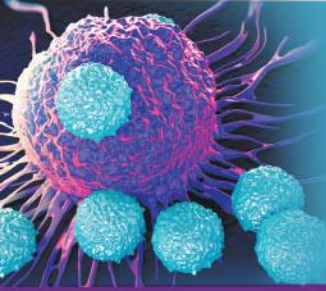

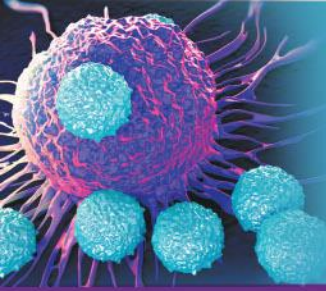
OVERVIEW
