EXPANDED AUTHORITIES / FDP

Allows certain privileges including automatic carryover of the unobligated balance from one budget period to another (except where noted). Pl's may also request an automatic no cost extension (up to one year) at the end of a competitive segment to continue work. Preaward costs up to 90 days prior to the budget period start date are allowed.

STREAMLINED NONCOMPETING AWARD PROCESS

Any grant covered by SNAP must have automatic carryover of unobligated balances. Waives the requirements to file an annual FFR until the final budget period of the competitive segment. Simplifies reporting requirements for RPPR progress reports(No section H Budget).
