2025 IMPLEMENTATION SCIENCE INSTITUTE

Implementation science (IS) has emerged as a discipline to bridge research-to-practice gaps in service of improving population health. Implementation science is the scientific study of methods to improve the adoption, implementation, and sustainment of evidence-based practices in health services settings. Increasingly, IS is being applied outside health settings, including in education, environmental science, and policy making.

The purpose of the Penn Implementation Science Institute (ISI) is to introduce participants to tools for designing and executing rigorous implementation research and practice. The ISI will provide an introduction to the foundations of IS (i.e., terminology, conceptual models and frameworks, study design). Students will also receive an overview of advanced topics including implementation strategies and deimplementation. The course faculty will cover tips for grant writing and skill development. We will also explicitly describe how principles of IS can be applied to practical implementation efforts.
