Dr. Scott Halpern, Dr. Meghan Lane-Fall Brooks and Dr. Mucio Delgado received a P30 award to establish a Patient-Oriented Research and Training to Accelerate Learning (Penn PORTAL) to build and diversify capacity in deploying patient-centered outcomes research (PCOR) within learning health systems (LHSs).

Promoting linkage to PrEP after HIV selftesting through a peerled intervention for MSM

Dr. Cedric Bien-Gund was awarded a K23 to leverage HIV self-testing and evaluate a peer-led intervention to support engagement in care and PrEP uptake through peer linkage after self-testing to expand the HIV prevention continuum among men who have sex with men (MSM).

IC-CSRisk Study: Implementation of Calculated Cesarean Section Risk during labor induction, a multi-site steppedwedge randomized rollout trial

Dr. Rebecca Hamm received an Ro1 award to study the effectiveness of using a cesarean risk calculator (provides clinicians and patients with an individualized percentage risk of cesarean for a given patient's labor induction) at diverse labor units within the US.

Leveraging the dyad: mechanisms of an intervention for psychological distress in chronic lung disease

Dr. Joanna Hart received an Ro1 award to close the gap that prevents effective and efficient palliative care delivery for patients with chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) through a trial comparing the effect of the Coping Skills Training (CST) program and a minimally enhanced usual care attention control on improving patients' and caregivers' outcomes.

Adapting the Penny Chatbot for Perinatal OUD Patients: COPILOT

Dr. Sara Kornfield was awarded an R34 by adapting a chatbot, Penny COPILOT, to address both loneliness and engagement in perinatal and opioid use disorder (OUD) care among perinatal women to make it appropriate for use by women who are pregnant and postpartum and dealing with OUD.

Dr. Dovie Watson was awarded a K23 to design and test implementation strategies to support HIV pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) provision for Black primary care patients and to facilitate Dr. Watson's goal to develop implementation strategies to achieve equitable HIV prevention outcomes among Black populations.
