

# **Development and validation of the Overall Fidelity Enactment Scale for Complex Interventions (OFES-CI)**

In many quality improvement (QI) and other complex interventions, assessing the fidelity with which participants 'enact' intervention activities (i.e., implement them as intended) is underexplored. Adapting the evaluative approach used in objective structured clinical examinations, we aimed to develop and validate a practical approach to assessing fidelity enactment—the Overall Fidelity Enactment Scale for Complex Interventions (OFES-CI).
