Postdoctoral Training Opportunity in Mental Health Services & Implementation Science - WashU

The Center for Mental Health Services Research at the George Warren Brown School of Social Work, Washington University in St. Louis (WashU), invites applications for postdoctoral training in mental health services research and implementation science. The program is supported by a National Research Service Award (NRSA) Institutional Training Grant from the National Institute of Mental Health (NIMH - T32 MH19960). Training includes:

- Faculty mentorship for planning and developing the candidate's own publications and research, in addition to developing and submitting rigorous grant proposals to NIH and other funders.
- Collaborating with CMHSR faculty on NIH-funded projects.
- Contributing to the scientific infrastructure and knowledge-based resources of the CMHSR, the WashU Dissemination and Implementation Research Core, and the Center for Holistic Interdisciplinary Research in Psychedelics (CHIRP) There are numerous opportunities to become involved in dissemination and implementation science at WashU.
