Achieving Maternal Equity and Transforming Health through Implementation Science and Training (AMETHIST@Penn).



Dr. Meghan Lane-Fall and Dr. Rebecca Hamm received a U award from the National Institute of Health (NIH) aiming to reduce maternal mortality, improve pregnancy, perinatal and postpartum care, and to address the factors that have led to severe disparities in outcomes for marginalized groups through the NIH Implementing a Maternal Health and PRegnancy Outcomes Vision for Everyone (IMPROVE) initiative. Dr. Lane-Fall and Dr. Hamm will co-direct the Achieving Maternal Equity and Transforming Health through Implementation Science and Training (AMETHIST@Penn) Implementation Science Hub to support IMPROVE Maternal Health Research Centers of Excellence (CoEs) and other IMPROVE investigators and to coordinate with NIH Staff Scientists, Project Staff, and the Data

Innovation and Coordinating Hub. The goal of AMETHIST@Penn is to advance public and maternal health equity.
