#### **COVID WATCH**

# ☐ Take amb. SpO2 and document value accordingly

☐ Communicate with care team to confirm most appropriate program

During CRC off-hours only:

- Confirm patient mobile number and ability to text
- Verify patient received and replied to enrollment text
- Provide education on texting program

#### **COVID PULSE**

- ☐ Take amb. SpO2 and document value accordingly
- ☐ Communicate with care team to confirm most appropriate program

During CRC off-hours only:

- Confirm patient mobile number and ability to text
- Provide education on texting program
- Retrieve pulse ox, ensuring batteries are installed, and provide education

#### **PENN MEDICINE AT HOME**

- ☐ Take amb. SpO2 and document value accordingly
- ☐ Communicate with care team to confirm most appropriate program

*During CRC off-hours only:* 

- ☐ Inform patient they will receive a call in the morning to go over program in detail
- ☐ Verify patient ability to use HRS app; <u>support patient in</u> <u>download and proper use</u>
- □ Retrieve pulse ox, ensuring batteries are installed, and provide education

### **COVID Watch / Pulse Teaching Points:**

- Instruct patient that they will receive text messages twice a day and they are to respond with how they are feeling (Watch) or their amb. SpO2 (Pulse)
- At any time patients can text in "WORSE" to escalate their care to a clinician

## **Pulse Ox Teaching Points:**

- Instruct patient to walk in place or around the house for 1 minute before measuring their SpO2
- Instruct patient to only perform amb. pulse ox if they feel safe to do so; otherwise, take pulse ox while seated
- ☐ Instruct patient not to wear nail polish
